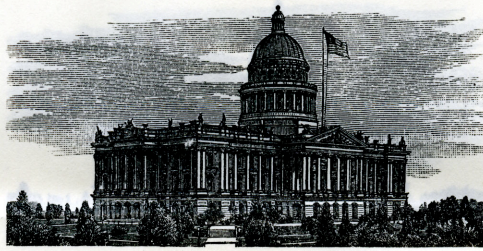

That said special election was held for the purpose of voting upon certain proposed amendments to the Constitution of the State of California, all of which said amendments were proposed by the Senate and Assembly of said State at the thirty-ninth session of the Legislature of said State, and were submitted to, for adoption by the people of the State of California.
